**Subject: MISREPRESENTATION BY A CERTAIN “ROMAR DARO”
AND/OR “INTEGRATED RISK MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION OF
THE PHILIPPINES, INC.” CLAIMING AFFILIATION WITH THE
SEC ILOILO EXTENSION OFFICE**

It has come to the attention of the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) Iloilo Extension Office that a certain individual using the name “Romar Daro” on the social media platforms Facebook and Messenger, and/or claiming affiliation with the “Integrated Risk Management Association of the Philippines, Inc.”, is falsely representing himself as being connected with, or authorized by, the SEC Iloilo Extension Office.

The public is hereby advised that Mr. Romar Daro and the aforementioned entity are not in any way connected with, nor authorized by, the Securities and Exchange Commission, including its Main Office and all Extension Offices, to represent, transact, or process any business on behalf of the Commission.

The Commission strongly warns the public against engaging in any communication or transaction with the said individual or entity under the false pretense of SEC affiliation, particularly in relation to the processing of online transactions. The public is hereby advised to report any suspicious individuals who may be misrepresenting themselves as employees of SEC to the Main Office or any of its Extension Offices.

The SEC upholds the highest standards of integrity, transparency, and accountability. Any misrepresentation of affiliation with the Commission may constitute violations punishable under the law. Violators shall be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.
