B. CLARIFICATION/S

QUERIES/CLARIFICATIONS	RESPONSES
1. General Scope The specs mentioned unlimited endpoint coverage. Does this apply to all types of devices (desktops, laptops, mobile devices, servers), or only to a defined subset?	There is no "unlimited endpoint coverage" mentioned on the Technical Specification.
2. Should the proposed solution support both on-premises deployment and cloud-based/hosted development, or is only one model acceptable?	We prefer on-premises deployment
3. For the centralized management console, is an on-prem appliance/server preferred, or is a cloud console acceptable?	Yes, at no additional cost to SEC.
4. In Technical Specifications page 72, Item 13 Must submit certification from the manufacturer that they are at least an Expert Partner of the product being offered May we request to relax the provision of being an Expert Partner of the Product being offered?	No, the requirement of being an Expert Partner of the Product being offered is needed to ensure capability of providing after sales support by the provider.

5. Section VIII Philippine Bidding Document Related Forms Page 83 Omnibus Sworn Statement Form May we respectfully submit this clarification to present to you how our Secretary's Certificate is structured where we have an Authorized Representative who is authorized to sign all bid related documents, and an Authorized Signatory who is authorized to sign all ensuing contracts. Please see attached cover sheet clarifying distinction between our Authorized Representative and Authorized Signatories and providing a clear understanding of why our Authorized Signatory is required to sign the Omnibus Sworn Statement.	The Secretary's Certificate must clearly state the capacity of each authorized signatory.
