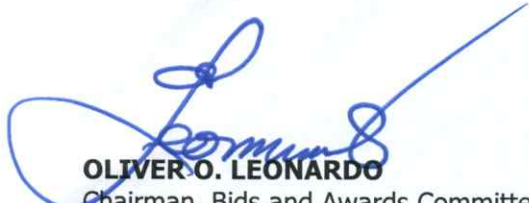

	What is the contract duration for this project?	One (1) year.
Section VII. Technical Specifications page 29	What is the Service Level Agreement (SLA) for the Enterprise Broadband requirement?	Reiterating the technical specifications, <i>"Enterprise broadband up to 500 Mbps with dynamic IP address via fiber optic cable. Fiber-based must be burst/download speeds are minimum of 30% of subscribed speed at 80% service reliability where available for the SEC Headquarters."</i>
	Is the Enterprise Broadband 500Mbps an additional line aside from the two 1Gbps leased lines?	Yes, it is an additional line aside from the two 1Gbps leased lines.
	Given the service required, is there a need to connect with US domains for it to be included in the requirements? And what specific documents can we present to comply?	Kindly state " <i>comply</i> " if you are compliant with the requirement on the Statement of Compliance portion of the technical specifications. Provide a detailed diagram as stated at the technical specifications. The requirement for NTC Certification is for the statement that the company providing

		internet data services for at least five (5) years.
	On the requirement for ISO 9001:2015 and ISO 27001:2013 certification, can an attestation letter certifying that the company have already completed the requirements for the renewal of ISO certifications suffice?	Please submit the required ISO 9001:2015 and ISO 27001:2013 certification
