Total Web Application Firewall (WAF) capacity in TB 2. Number of SSL Certificates 3. Total Content Delivery Network (CDN) capacity in TB 4. Number of Zones 5. DDoS Mitigation capacity in TB 6. HTTP/HTTPs request handling capacity in TB	Section VII. Technical Specification A: 1. Minimum of 1000 WAF Rule Sets. WAF capacity is determined by the number of rules/rule sets for deployment. 2. Plan should allow: a. Full (or Full(Strict)) SSL/TLS Encryption Mode. b. Uploading 1 custom legacy certificate pack c. Uploading 25 custom modern certificate packs d. Using 100 advanced certificates. 3. CDN - Total Data Transfer up to 15TB and up to 150 CDN MM requests. 4. 1 Zone for Enterprise-Primary-Domains. 1 Zone for Advanced Certificates Manager - Domains. 5. No maximum limit or "cap" on the size or duration of an attack.

Technical Specification A: The bidder shall submit relevant documents demonstrating the company's systematic approach to environmental management. Acceptable forms of evidence include, but are not limited to: • A dedicated Sustainability Report or Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) report with a section detailing waste management initiatives. • An Environmental Management System (EMS) certification (e.g., ISO 14001) or a relevant excerpt from its documentation. • A formal Waste Management Plan or Policy document used by the company. The submitted document(s) should clearly illustrate the company's commitment to and procedures for effectively managing waste generated during operations.
Omnibus Sworn Statement Form Q: May we respectfully submit this clarification to present to you how our Secretary Certificate is structured where we have an Authorized Representative who is authorized to sign all bid related documents, and an Authorized Signatory who is authorized to sign all ensuing contracts. Please see attached cover sheet clarifying the distinction between our Authorized Representative and Authorized Signatories and providing a clear understanding of why our Authorized Signatory is required to sign the Omnibus Sworn Statement.	Omnibus Sworn Statement Form A: The Secretary Certificate must clearly state the capacity of each authorized signatory.
