Upcoming Integration of eFAST and eSECURE Systems

We are pleased to announce the upcoming **integration of the eFAST and eSECURE systems**, part of our continued efforts to streamline services, improve user experience, and enhance data security.

This integration aims to provide users with a **more unified, efficient, and secure** access platform for managing their transactions and account information.

What This Means for Users:

- Your eFAST account will be linked to your existing eSECURE account as we move to a single, unified system.
- Users who have not yet verified their Tax Identification Number (TIN) may continue to log in using their current eFAST credentials during the transition period; however, completing TIN verification is strongly encouraged to ensure a smooth migration and uninterrupted access.
- Some user action may be required to ensure a smooth transition (see below).
 - As part of the integration process, it is **crucial that users validate their accounts using the correct Tax Identification Number (TIN)** associated with their original eFAST enrollment. Failure to do so may result in **account mismatch or migration issues**.
 - If you have recently completed account validation but did **not use your enrolled TIN**, we encourage you to update your details as soon as possible.
