

## PUBLIC ADVISORY

### WARNING AGAINST UNAUTHORIZED AND FRAUDULENT WEBSITE IMPERSONATING PROJECT DUO INTEGRATED COMMUNICATIONS CORP.

The Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission” or “SEC”) hereby warns the public against an unauthorized and fraudulent website, identified as: <https://www.projectduotech.com/#/> which falsely represents itself as affiliated with PROJECT DUO INTEGRATED COMMUNICATIONS CORP. (“the Company”) and purports to offer loan products and related financial services to the public.



Based on the Commission's review and verification of available information, it has been determined that:

- The subject website is NOT owned, operated, authorized, or affiliated with PROJECT DUO INTEGRATED COMMUNICATIONS CORP.; and
- Any representation to the contrary is false and misleading.

Accordingly, the Commission strongly cautions the public that:

- Any loan offers, solicitations, payment instructions, or requests for personal or sensitive information originating from the subject website are unauthorized;
- Such activities exhibit hallmarks of fraudulent and deceptive schemes, including corporate impersonation and potential misuse of personal data; and
- These acts are not sanctioned by the SEC and are not part of the legitimate operations of the Company.

The foregoing acts may constitute violations of existing laws, rules, and regulations, including those relating to fraudulent misrepresentation, unauthorized lending activities, and unlawful processing of personal data, and may subject the responsible parties to appropriate administrative, civil, and/or criminal sanctions.

The public is advised to exercise extreme caution and to refrain from engaging, transacting, or disclosing personal information through the said website or any related channels.

Persons who may have been contacted by or transacted with the subject website are strongly encouraged to immediately report the matter to the Commission and other appropriate authorities for proper investigation.

The Commission reiterates its firm commitment to protecting financial consumers and to aggressively pursuing entities engaged in fraudulent, deceptive, or unauthorized lending activities, particularly those conducted through digital platforms.
