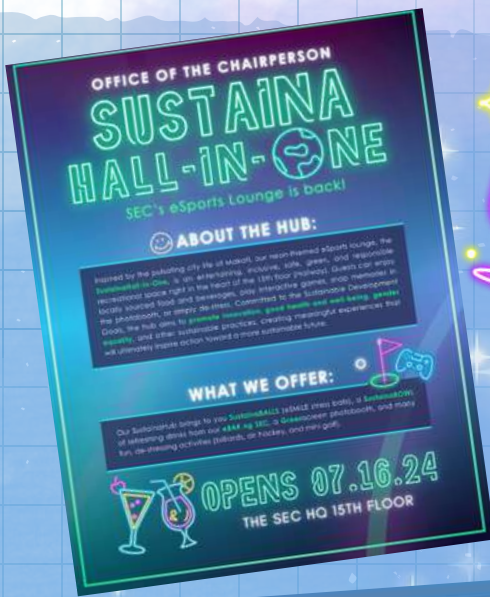

UPCYCLE & REPURPOSE

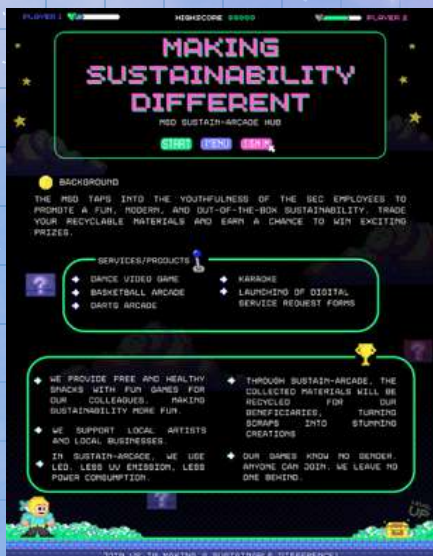
The Office of the General Counsel proved that sustainability is always in style by turning second-hand items into new treasures!

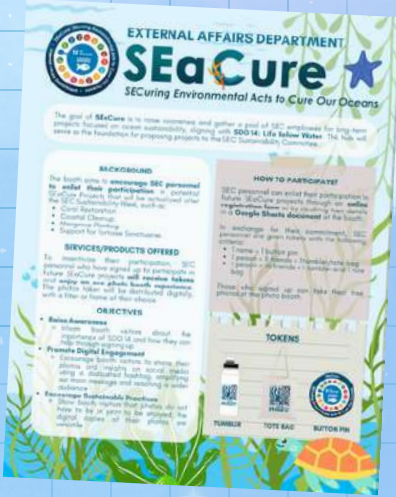


LEARNING & LEISURE



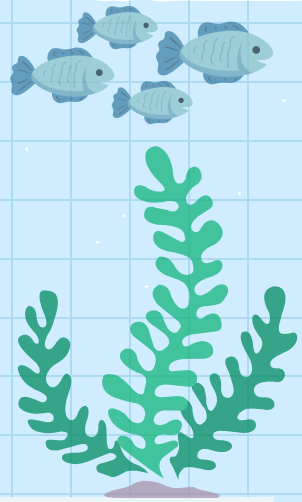

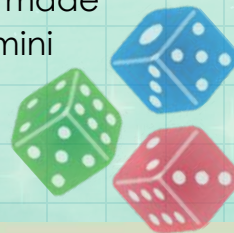
SUSTAINABLE SEAS START HERE

Hand-Me-Down Books

Using pre-owned books, the reading nook lowers paper consumption and conserves natural resources by reducing the demand for new book production, and prevents used books from ending up in landfills (SDG12).



Eco-Friendly Materials

Sustainable Furniture: The nook is furnished with recycled or sustainably sourced items, including staff-donated plants and furniture.



Healthier Break Time

The Eko-Suuk offers a cozy reading space and café-style spot for coffee breaks, promoting well-being (SDG3), lifelong learning (SDG4), and a productive work environment (SDG8).



By integrating these practices, the Eko-Suuk champions environmental sustainability and inspires the community to adopt greener and more sustainable habits.
